> Is there a way I can determine if a specific link is a file that can be downloaded? Perhaps with the response header or the response code when I set the URL\_PATH to the file?

I found a Content-Type field in the response header that tells me what the link is.... Oh, and there is a property named CONTENT\_TYPE, too. Go figure... Unfortunately, the only way I seem to be able to trigger a response is by using the Get method.

Is there a way to trigger response without downloading the contents of a page first? I am currently using something like

```
!Null = Get(/String_Array)
self -> GetProperty, CONTENT_TYPE=ct
IF ct NE 'html' THEN !Null = Get(FILENAME=filename)
```

But this requires two calls to Get.
