```
array=[1,2,3,4,5]  
printf, array
```

I get an error saying it must be a scalar or an array of 1 element. There must be a way to write an array with say 5 columns on the same line right? I thought about a loop to run through each subscript, but that would print them on separate lines. How simple is this which I'm obviously missing
