I just wanted a confirmation on a point. Is it true that by the time a cleanup routine specified by the 'cleanup' keyword to xmanager is called, the widget is already destroyed? Therefore, you can't store stuff like handle ids in any info structure residing in the user value of the top level widget since it won't be there for your cleanup routine to free. Seems like one is forced to use commons.

Does the 'kill_notify' keyword to widget_base work differently? Not that I want to use it, since it's ignored in routines managed by Xmanager.
