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One important point - "catch" is expensive. It's better to put it outside of the for loop, and just use a "start" index to continue. Something like:

```
start = 0
catch, err
if (err ne 0) then begin
    start = i + 1
    print, 'bad error'
endif
for i=start, finish do begin
    ...
endfor
```
