> I have an array and want to write the values to a geotiff. I have another GEOTiff file of the same area with exactly same dimension. I read this GEotiff and extracted its Geokey info (GeoKeys). I use this command to create a new Geotiff using this Geokey:

>

> TIFF\_write, test.tiff, data, GEOTIFF=GeoKeys

>

> I got this error message "Keyword FLOAT not allowed in call to: TIFF\_WRITE", do you what is wrong with this?

Haha! I'd try putting quotes around "test.tiff". That might help.  
Strange error message, though. :-)
