Sorry for picking up an old post, but I've tried changing preferred browser in IDL under Window->Preferences->General->Web Browser and setting Chrome (instead of Firefox). I also tried activating Use internal/external web browser with no change in the behaviour. I also tried using the "windows" option for export and typed in the command line:

```
set IDL_ONLINE_HELP_HTML_BROWSER=chrome
or
set IDL_ONLINE_HELP_HTML_BROWSER="C:\Program Files
(x86)\Google\Chrome\Application\chrome.exe"
```

neither worked. Pressing F1 on a command will always result in firefox opening.

Has anybody else tried this?
