I am trying to figure out a better method to read each of these files and save the variables to different named arrays or structures so that I can then plot several days of data in the same graph. The method i've been using right now involves a lot of coding (shown below for first 2 files). Is there a better way to do this so that I can then plot multiple arrays from different .save files on the same graph? Thank you.
