> I was hoping to save my cqWindow to a publication quality image using Imagemagick. I've run cgHasImageMagick and get

> IDL> Print, cgHasImageMagick()
1
```

> but under File, Save Window As... -> I only have the options of Postscript File, PDF File, or Raster Image File. Is there a way to get the Raster Image Files vis ImageMagick from the graphics window or do I need to just save as a postscript and manually convert the file in ImageMagick? I'm using IDL version 8.1.0 on a mac.

Yes, and ...

Is the resulting image of crappy quality? In my experience, the output from cgWindow is at least as good as (and sometimes better) than the output from the function graphics routines.
