> I want my ticks up (inwards) and not down. Is it not possible to do that when using cgHistoplot?

Not with the code as written. Upward ticks interfere with the histogram polygons that are drawn. Of course, you aren't using polygons, but this seems like a needless complication to me. You can probably get what you want, just by using PLOT, Histogram(data), ..., PSYM=10.
