g=/home/mark/matchup/MIRS_AMSU line as above, without quotes.)

Anyway, something like the following should do it (untested):

```
g='/home/mark/matchup/MIRS_AMSU'  
f=file_search('*.nc',count=nfiles)  
if nfiles gt 0 then begin  
    flist = join(f, ' ')  
    spawn, 'mv ' + strjoin(f, ' ') + g  
end
```
