I agree. This is why I made my own version of cgBoxPlot based on David's code. But I keep it for me, because I wouldn't be happy if people complained about something I give for free.

> (b) You will never find outliers in the the first column data!!!

I don't know about this, but I think you should provide a simple test case that reproduces this error.

> I request David to refine the above function,

David is providing the coyote library for free. It is not nice to "request" him to do something. Furthermore, he is on holidays and probably doesn't care about your problem at all right now.

I see two solutions:

1. you build your own boxplot based on David's code (free)

2. you buy IDL 8.3 and use IDL's boxplot (not free):
