A 2d grid of data is the same as an "image", and third or fourth dimensions (e.g. time or atmospheric levels) are simply a "pile of images".

Depending on the size of your array you could do some dimension juggling (https://www.idlcoyote.com/tips/rebin_magic.html, case study 1) or use a loop over the other dimensions.
