IDL 8.3:

```
IDL> dict = DICTIONARY('data', FINDGEN(10))
IDL> PRINT, dict.data[2:5]
% Subscripts are not allowed with object properties.
% Execution halted at: $MAIN$
IDL> PRINT, (dict.data)[2:5]
2.00000 3.00000 4.00000 5.00000
```

IF the syntax: dict.data[2:5] now works in 8.4, this would be so great!
The use of () makes nested dictionaries really cumbersome to use
