> perhaps I have missed some basic info in some of the gshhs discussion, but I have a problem that islands seem to disappear when using cgmap\_gshhs (newest library release of data and procedures). This is a code example. There should be lots of small islands here. Am I doing something wrong?

OK, I haven't tried this with gsshg 2.3, but it seems to work with gsshg 2.2.3 and 2.3.2. The only change I made to your code was to add a MINAREA=0 keyword to the cgMap\_GSHHS call.
