>   ALIGN=align, $  
>   ASPECT=aspect, $  
>   POSITION=position, $  
>   SINGLE_PLOT=single_plot, $  
>   WASPECT=waspect  
>

> So can you fix this. Very thanks!
```

You can fix it by either updating your Coyote Library to the latest version, or by changing MARGIN=0 to /SINGLE_PLOT.
