> Am I misunderstanding the documentation, or is there a bug with some string methods?
>
> When a string has more than one character, substring() works as I expected, from the
documentation:
>
> IDL> str='ab'
> IDL> print,str.substring(-1)
> b
>
> But if the string has length 1, I get an empty string:
>
> IDL> str='a'
> IDL> print,str.substring(-1)
>
> IDL> print,strlen(str.substring(-1))
> 0
> IDL>
>
> A similar problem happens with remove():
>
> IDL> str='ab'
> IDL> print,str.remove(-1)
> a
> IDL> str='a'
> IDL> print,str.remove(-1)
> a

Drats, that looks like a bug. Good catch Paulo. I'll try to slip it into the next patch release.
