In addition to the other methods mentioned:

```
IDL> print, (A le 100) * A
```

```
  1   2   3
  0   4   0
```

And, if you really want to know if there was some way to do it with
greater than operator, yes you can:

```
IDL> print, (1B - (A gt 100)) * A
```

```
  1   2   3
  0   4   0
```
