> over the last week I have been struggling with a IDLBridge problem that neither google nor any
forum could help with. I am using IDL8.3 on a MacPro, OSX 10.9.5. The problem can be boiled
down to this very simple lines of code:
>
> cproc = obj new('IDL IDLBridge',output=")
> cproc->execute,'print,"Hello world"
> cproc->execute,'print,"Hello world"',/nowait
> The first execute line works perfectly fine. The second one with the /nowait keyword results in
an error:
> % Attempt to call undefined method: 'IDL_IDLBRIDGE::ExecuteTimer'.
> I could reproduce the error on IDL8.4 on the same setup, as well as on a MacBook Pro on
10.10 with IDL8.3. The error could not be reproduced on the leaky IDL7.2 on an (unknown) Unix
flavour.
> Does anyone have a solution or explanation of the problem?
