> The find.pro script asks for the desired FWHM, background, etc. and it prints on the screen the values. No file is create though. What am i missing?

I think you are missing the fact that the PRINT in this case is a keyword, not a command. (Bad choice of keyword name for whoever wrote the program.):

Find, image, Print='myfile.txt'
