> It's easy to do with new graphics:

>

> x = findgen(100)

> y = randomu(seed,100)

> p = plot(x,y,TITLE='\$M_{\U(22C6)}\$', FONT_SIZE=30)

It's pretty easy with Coyote Graphics, too, if you are using IDL 8.2 or higher. First, make sure DejaVuSans is your true-type font. I usually do this in my IDL start-up file.

```
cgSet_TTFont, 'Dejavusans'
```

Then, to make the plot:

```
cgPlot, x,y,TITLE='M!D!Z(22C6)!N', Font=1, Output='test.png'
```
