I routinely work in IDL with files greater than 100 MB. Once in a while I have to process files bigger than 1GB. I have a dedicated workstation for this processing, but my total memory is 128 M. The simplest solution for me was to limit the chunk of data loaded into the memory and use a loop to go through the whole file.
