directory = 'C:\Users\Images'

file\_mkdir, directory

write\_tif, directory + '\' + name, tvrd ()

I overlaid a grid on the top of the images. When the images exported as tif files the grid was not red any more, it appears in white colour. To keep the colour of the grid I used the cgsnapshot instead
