Does the funpack command run at the command line (outside of IDL)?
READFITS() simply spawns to open a pipe to the funpack command:

```
spawn,'funpack -S ' + filename, unit=unit,/sh
```

> <funpack: command not found>.

> (Does it have something do with the shell in which the command is running? Because, while  
READ_SDO runs in tcsh, the READFITS error command is preceded by the name of the shell,  
which is either 'sh' or 'bash')
