Seconded. You can just create 6xN array, then access any row you want without all the trouble of naming them

```
;Create an array  
array = randomu(seed, 6, 100)
```

```
;Pick a row  
iRow = 4  
theRow = array[*, iRow]
```

"iRow" is essentially the name of your row...
