>  
> I am currently working on an IDL project in which I want to find a specified file. Once I set the  
definition for my "IF"-statement, I want to create a new folder below the file...  
>  
> So this is basically what it looks like:  
>  
> IF (substring\_month EQ '01') then begin  
> FILE\_MKDIR, '/January'  
> FILE\_MOVE, dirname[k], 'January'  
> ENDIF

Well, '/January' specifies the root directory. To create a new directory in the current working  
directory, use './January' instead.

Of course, this assumes the current working directory is where you find the specified file. A more  
robust piece of code would parse the result from whatever function you use to find the file.
