The exact error code I get is just "131" which is an internal undefined error in the .sav-file. As the data sets are processed in a FOR-loop, the code "131" will simply give the information that this file could not be processed and then continue with the next one.

That's why I can not give you more detailed information...there simply is not error information. Anyway, the error occurs (when I have e.g. 4 processes) at the same time in all windows.... If I stop 3 processes and reduce the number to one remaining process, the "131" disappears and the file are from that point processed correctly.
