> I wanted to check whether my array A has any zero element and if so then simply return a zero array (with two zeroes). I typed the following but am not sure if it's correct.

>

> A FLOAT = Array[58]

>

- > FOR i=0L, 57 DO BEGIN
- > IF A[i] EQ 0 THEN RETURN, [0,0]
- > ENDFOR

There are a whole host of articles on my web page explaining why it will be impossible to find a zero value in an array of floats. I'll just give you the bottom line: use Floats_Equal from the Coyote Library to do this kind of comparison:

IF Floats_Equal(a[i],0) THEN RETURN, [0,0]
