> check\_filename.pro is in the directory. The permission is also ok.

> Is this error from the two versions of ubuntu?  
> Appreciate any tips to solve this errors.

This looks like a path problem. Could it be that at the old system you had two versions of check\_filename? Or that you change the working directory within IDL before calling the function (and that the directory where the function is is not in the path)?
