I would like to have a small piece of text below the button that indicates the currently loaded color table. Where would the current color table index and its name be stored? I can't find it anywhere. I also need the table number to preserve the current color table, as the script executes a color plot, and then a different plot which must be black and white. In between runs I don't want the user to have to reselect the color table, but unfortunately it is reverted to black and white to properly generate the second plot. There's probably something simple I am missing...
