Do you mean the file *contents*? [hard]

- > ros=btstruc.ros, \$
- > readme=readme.txt}

> Everything works, except the text file!

The above pseudo-code tells me you are trying to get the file *name* as part of the structure.

But somehow I don't think that's what you want....right?
