> And often one does not want to specify or know the numerical location of the legend, but rather one just wants to place the legend snug in a corner of the plot . Here's how to do this with the direct graphics procedure AL\_LEGEND

- > IDL> cgplot,indgen(10)
- > IDL> al\_legend,['This is a very long title'],lines=0,/right ;Place legend snug in upper right
- > IDL> al\_legend,['short'],lines=1,/bottom,/right ;Place legend snug in lower right

In truth, Coyote probably stole most of the code from AL\_Legend. He told me once that almost all of his good ideas were first thought up at NASA. ;-)
