Would it be helpful if the red zoom box snapped to the closest datapoint (in the X direction) while you were drawing it?

I dunno about Wayne, but I would definitely *not* want that to be the default.

I would like me, not my data, to be in control of where the zoom box goes.

I do a lot of overshooting in my zoomboxing when I am drilling down to very low levels so the snapping to the closest data point would not be appreciated.
