> I'm using coyote graphics. 'psym=10' works fine on a cgplot line But when i try to use it in cgplots it does Not work. I've seen this referenced in other posts that this is normal. I'm not sure why this is so, and how to get around it if it is normal.

All PSYM values in Coyote Graphics routines are passed along to cgSymCat for resolution. If the PSYM value is 10 on a Coyote Graphic routine, cgSymCat returns 10, so that is what the value of PSYM will be in the plot. So, I'm not sure what the problem might be, or how this would be different from normal IDL plotting routines. Perhaps if you could provide an example I could be more helpful.
