> I don't think this bug has been reported here, but it appears the /Xsty keyword to PLOT()  
wasn't allowed in V8.3

>  
> IDL> a = plot(indgen(12),indgen(12),/xsty)  
> % PLOT: Duplicate keyword XSTY in call to: DATAAXES::SETPROPERTY  
> % Execution halted at: \$MAIN\$  
>  
> IDL> print,!version  
> { x86\_64 darwin unix Mac OS X 8.3 Nov 15 2013 64 64}  
>  
> The code works fine in V8.4 and V8.5. But some of my users are still using V8.3 --Wayne

This inconvenience indeed disappeared since V8.4, but is still there (8.5) when using the SCATTERPLOT function.

My workaround is to explicitly change the property value:  
IDL> pl = scatterplot(/TEST)  
IDL> pl.XSTYLE = 1

alx.
