>> In this case, nothing happens at all - no plot, no plot window, no error message.

>

> I would guess your !path has been compromised.

> IDL> print, routine_info('plot', /source, /function)

> { PLOT C:\Program Files\Exelis\IDL85\lib\graphics\plot.pro}

>

>

> Jim P.

I just tried this, no luck:

```
IDL> print,routine_info('plot',/source,/function)
```

```
% Attempt to call undefined function: 'PLOT'.
```

```
% Execution halted at: $MAIN$
```
