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Does anybody know how to move (slide) an image (or a portion of the image) around in a window without using the TV command in IDL 2.4.0?

We want to develop a display where new real-time image data enters on the right side and old image data scrolls to the left. This can be done by building a loop that shifts the whole image array, replaces the profile on the right and reTVs the whole image to the window, but of course it takes a lot of time. We hope there is a way to just move the data in the window by a certain amount without having to shift and reTV whole image.
