> for i=1,n-1 do temp=create_struct(temp,tagname[i],tagvalue[i])
> terribly inefficient, better to create a string and then use
> execute(string)
```

Hmmm... Yes! EXECUTE() is a non-starter, this needs to be fully usable in compiled code. But I'm sure there is some clever way to do this with fewer calls to CREATE_STRUCT(). If I come up with something that actually is faster, I'll post to this thread.
