```

Strange... the only other idea I have at the moment is to try this code:

```
c This is a test code  
  write(6,*) "--- Hello World ---"  
  stop  
end
```

Just in case the Windows messes up the stdout...

Other than that, I don't know.

A workaround would be to redirect your output in Windows to a text file:  
spawn, 'test.exe > myOutput.txt', result, errResult  
and then check the contents of myOutput.txt.
