- > by default, but setting NOCLIP=0 should turn clipping back on and
- > prevent text from
- > being written outside the plot axes. I've discovered that this works
- > fine as long as you
- > use Hershey fonts, but it does not work when you use hardware fonts.

I tend not to use the hardware fonts on-screen because they cannot be rotated - it makes Y-axis labels look pretty crude. Usually one of the Hershey fonts suffices, and when I want to make hard copy, I use one of the Postscript fonts.

I realize that's not much help: sorry.
