Scott Applequist writes:

> When using the function TRIGRID, my program aborts if I attempt
> to specify the keywords GS and LIMITS. I.e.,
>
> % Keyword GS not allowed in call to: TRIGRID
> % Execution halted at: \$MAIN\$
>
> Leaving these keywords out allows the function to run, but it then
> uses the defaults and this is not the result I desire. The
> documentation quite clearly states that these keywords are allowed.

Actually, these "keywords" are positional parameters and not keywords at all, although you can certainly make the argument that the *ought* to be keywords! :-)
