Hello, IDL users -

I'm using !p.multi to make a grid of 1-d plots under VMS IDL 2.4.0. In order to have the plots stack perfectly, I set !x.margin and !y.margin to 0. Unfortunately, this leaves no margin around the grid for annotation.

I tried setting !p.region, but this seems to override the !p.multi settings. How do I restrict the output of !p.multi to a certain region?
