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R. Bauer writes:

- > If I have data between the range 101 and 999 I got no tics labeld.
- > I do not like to extend the range!
- > Any idea or example?

I don't think there is any easy or even semi-easy way to do this. I've tried a couple of times. I think what you can do is put the labels on yourself with XYOUTS, but this works best if you are not too concerned with writing a general routine that works in all cases.

You can use !Y.Window to find the endpoints of your axis, and then you can usually find a way to get the labels in more or less the correct location.
