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Hi,

I use a Visual TX100M X-terminal (currently with 2-Meg memory) sometimes to display IDL plots, and for some reason, the backing pixmap does not get set. So whenever I cover/uncover the plot window, the covered part comes out blank. It gets rather annoying when one is trying to build up a complicated plot. I would appreciate any suggestions/hints to avoid this problem.

I have the same problem with ghostview, but that I can live with.

terminal windows, clocks, xload, etc., do NOT exhibit this problem. i.e., when I cover an xterm window with another and uncover it, I can still see all the stuff that was covered.
