> Using XYOUTS in normalized coordinates is probably the best you'll get (You'd
> need to set the positions of the plots manually as !P.multi doesn't leave you
> any space.

To leave space for titles and other annotation, you can use the "outside" margin system variables !Y.OMargin and !X.OMargin. But be careful. These measure space in "character" units. Some experimentation is almost always required. :-)
