- > resize event when it is resized. After releasing the mouse button when I
- > resize the top base that contains my draw window, I get dozens of
- > events corresponding
- > to each intermediate size of the base as it is being dragged to its new
- > size. When the objects in the view are complex, resizing the window can
- > cause a noticeable delay.
