If you make IDL reading into the structure test you made, it wants to read as much characters as you defined for test. As you wrote fewer char's to the file, reading afterwards has to give an EOF error. In your example, if you define

```
test = {name:'xxxxx',$
        number:'xxxxxx',$
        city:'xxxxxxxxxxx'}
```

there won't be any error.
