If you have a GX graphics card, or other 8 bit device, there can be an interesting problem if you run an AnswerBook in the same session as Wave. A by-product of them ransacking the available colours is that when you quit OpenWindows the console displays white on white...

You can type blind and get back into OpenWindows okay, but a better solution seems to be to power up using openwin -nobanner. Set this in the .profile and it seems to get round the problem.
