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Hi,

I seem to be having the same problem but with less severity though it is still rather inconvenient.

This is a new machine and I installed RH 6.1 on it. Originally I was not able to run any graphics command and I would get the dreaded X visual not supported. After installing XFree86 4.0 (as suggested in an earlier post), the graphics started working but the window does not refresh itself. If any part of the plot window is covered, it is gone for good. Also I don't know how to get to the pseudo 8-bit mode so I can use standard color tables.

So the questions are:

- how do I get the window to auto refresh after being covered or minimized
- how do I use standard color tables

Below is the output from 'help, /device'. The graphic card is Diamond Viper 770D which uses NVIDIA TNT2 chipset.
