No, I cant tell you why, but I had a similar problem 6 months ago with drag and drop, altho I never worked out when/how it first occurred. I sent my computer (Toshiba laptop 430CDT, Win95) back to the vendor for expert help, and the best the vendor experts could do over 2 days (after trying various reinstallations) was

1) ascertain from Microsoft that Microsoft had heard of the problem

2) advice from Microsoft that they could not offer either explanation or fix

3) reimage the disc, ie. do a total low-level disc reformat and reinstallation of everything.

That does not answer your question , but be assured that , unlike Bill Gates, I sympathize.
