Didn't work. But here's the reason. According to the procedure,

device, font='*', get_fontnames=list_of_fonts
```

list\_of\_fonts doesn't contain entries such as "7x13", although the xlsfonts command definately says they're there.

I tried substituting a type1 font name as I did for widget\_control, but it didn't work. My bet is that the .Xdefaults fontlist option no longer exists - it's not mentioned \*anywhere\* in idlhelp.
